Sheeting & Cladding Specialist Applied-Skills Programme

Fully Funded for CITB Members

The Specialist Applied-Skills Programme (formerly Specialist Apprenticeship Programme) is a 12 month training and qualification programme that culminates in the achievement of a Level 2 NVQ Diploma in Cladding Occupations - Roof Sheeting and Cladding. The schedule consists of 24 off-site training days at our training centre in Melksham, Wiltshire. The off-site training is reinforced by supervised on-site training by an appropriately qualified employee.

The final stage of the Specialist Applied-Skills Programme is the NVQ assessment – this is achieved via the On-Site Assessment Training route. Our assessor will arrange a number of on-site visits to observe and assess the new entrants at work. These observations contribute to the evidence gathered by both the new entrant and the assessor for insertion into the new entrant's NVQ portfolio of work place activities. The entrants have 6 months to complete and achieve this assessment stage of their NVQ.

On certification, the new entrant will be able to apply for their blue CSCS Skilled Workers Card.

Course Structure

This 24 day off-site training programme covers the following:

- Introduction, induction and Employment Rights and Responsibilities
- Overview of roof sheeting and cladding, terminology, materials and components, safe working practices
- Preparing materials and equipment, fixing techniques, single skin and composite panels, double skin and insulation, variants and roof lights, flashings and apertures, rain water goods
- Repair of existing cladding systems, refurbishment of existing wall claddings
- Health and Safety, Working at Heights, UKATA Asbestos Awareness, Abrasive Wheels, Manual Handling, Emergency

Please note: The Specialist Applied-Skills Programme must complete 24 months after the start of training to ensure payment of grants. New Entrants must pass the CSCS Working at Height H&S test and obtain the red trainee card within three months of the programme start. Employers will be required to nominate a Work Based Recorder who must have 5 years pitched roofing experience. The WBR will supervise the new entrant and will need to attend a short training course within 6 weeks of the programme commencement.
